

So far, 2020 has been a record year for illegal dumping at our Freeman Street recycling location. The problem has reached the point that it has become necessary to install security cameras to monitor the site.

The intended purpose of this site is to provide residents with a place to dispose of trimmed/downed tree branches and Christmas tree recycling. Only items that can be chipped are permitted. The recycled mulch is free for the taking by Robesonia residents for private non-commercial use.

Who may use the site:

YES

Robesonia residents with a Borough issued permit (obtain free permit at Borough Hall).

What is permitted:

YES

Tree branches, limbs, and small trees (think Christmas tree) of size that can be chipped.

What is **NOT** permitted:

NO

Non-resident use.

NO

COMMERCIAL USE (contractor, tree service, mowing service, landscaper etc.) even if customer is a Robesonia resident.

Commercial dumping is costly to the Borough and will be referred to the Police Department for prosecution and recovery of clean-up costs.

NO

Tree trunks, tree roots, logs, grass, bamboo, leaves or any form of yard waste.

NO

Removal of dirt, stones, cinders - these items are stored on-site for use by our Streets Department.
